Mayor Stoner reported that he, Terry Summers, and Callie McFarland had a nice time at the Illinois Municipal League Conference last week, and thanked the City and citizens of Monticello for allowing them to attend.

NEW BUSINESS:

Resolution 2021-52: Resolution for Approval of Conditional Use – 804 W William Street, City of Monticello, Piatt County, IL

Jim Grabarczyk presented the following:

Applicant - Brianne Leverenz, owner of 804 W William Street, zoned RD-Urban Residential, has requested a conditional use permit for a major home occupation (Hair Salon). The applicant will be using a portion of their driveway for off-street parking.

The City of Monticello zoning ordinance does not allow for a major home occupation without issuance of a conditional use permit. Public comment was solicited for the Public Hearing held September 20th, 2021 and none was received. The Planning & Zoning Board discussed and has recommended to City Council on September 20th, 2021 to approve this conditional use permit. Brianne Leverenz was present for any questions from the Council.

With no questions or concerns from the Council, a motion was made by Alderman Brock, and seconded by Alderwoman Harlan, to approve Ordinance 2021-52. The motion passed 7-0.

Ordinance 2021-53: Approving Conditional Use and Variance Requests for Sage Crossing Proposed Lot 5, Monticello

Jim Grabarczyk presented the following:

Kirby Medical Center previously submitted a Preliminary Plan to subdivide one of the larger parcels of property to create the Sage Crossing Commercial Subdivision. To move forward with any development, the developer must address any zoning actions. A conditional use permit is required to allow construction of a 38,200 square foot medical office building and associated parking. The applicant is requesting reducing the parking requirements from the required off-street parking of 117 spaces to 90 spaces for the proposed development. Public comment was solicited on September 20, 2021 at the Planning & Zoning Board Meeting, and on that date the Board recommended City Council approval. Steve Tenhouse, Kirby Hospital, and Neil Finlen with Farnsworth Group were present for questions from the Council. Alderman Brock asked if construction would be starting soon on this building, and Mr. Tenhouse replied he was not sure when it would begin, as they are in initial stages and just received approval tonight.

A motion was made by Alderman Reed, and seconded by Alderman Burris, to approve Ordinance 2021-53. The motion passed 7-0.

ALDERMEN'S/ALDERWOMEN'S REPORT:

Alderman Koon reported that he had the pleasure of hosting the Director of Illinois State Tourism last Friday. She was able to visit Monticello and had many nice things to say about our community.

Monticello Historic Preservation Commission
August 3, 2021

The Monticello Historic Preservation Commission met Tuesday, August 3rd at the Livingston Center.

Members present: Keddy Hutson, Chad Johnson, Leigh Anderson, Maynard Suhre & Ryan Tracy.

Public Participation: N/A

City Participation: Callie McFarland

Chairman Hutson called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. The minutes of the May 4, 2021 Historic Preservation Commission meeting were presented for approval. Motion was made by Maynard, seconded by Chad. Motion carried. The minutes of the July 6, 2021 Historic Preservation Commission were presented for approval. Motion was made by Maynard, seconded by Chad. Motion carried.

Old Business

Keddy gave an update on the Official Notice for the Certified Local Government grant for an exterior feasibility study of the Monticello Community Building, which the City of Monticello received \$7,592.

There has been no movement from either the Monticello Township or the Corries, regarding their interest in applying for local landmark status.

Maynard gave an update on the Downtown Historic Recognition Plaques for the three current and former churches in downtown Monticello. He has mock-ups for them and will proceed. Callie will reach out to these owners as well for local landmark potential.

Chad brought up the brick sidewalks in need of repair on Piatt, Lafayette, Bond and others. He will do a review of the locations to confirm where the brick sidewalks are and the level of needed repair.

During the Historic Watchdog Report Chad mentioned the banners that are peeling off on some of the window hanging banners in the Courthouse Square Historic District. Callie will contact the owners of the building to gauge their interest in replacement.

New Business

HPC Project Review – 450 S. Charter. The owners of the property have applied for a conditional use permit to allow an additional accessory structure on the property (inground pool). The Committee saw no issues with the request, and will provide comments to the Planning & Zoning Board reflecting this.

Downtown Lighting Study – Callie presented to the HPC a new lighting study proposal for the Courthouse Square to see different options the downtown could have for architectural lighting. The HPC approved and will respond in writing as such.

Keddy also commented on the potential of another National Historic District, including the W. Main Street and S. Piatt Street neighborhoods, tying into downtown. He will reach out to Alive

Novak about getting historic preservation survey as a class project for University of Illinois students.

No further business. Meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m. The next meeting will be held Tuesday September 7, 2021

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT (S23) TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF MONTICELLO, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, has completed the 23rd supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Monticello, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted since the prior supplement to the Code of Ordinances of this City; and

- Section 2. Such supplements shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the City Council and the Clerk of the City of Monticello is hereby authorized and ordered to insert such supplement into the copy of the Code of Ordinances kept on file in the Office of the Clerk.
- Section 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
