BACKGROUND:

The Monticello City Council included \$324,000 of Motor Fuel Tax expenditures in the FY2019 budget for the Market Street pedestrian crossing, Washington Street Streetscape work and associated improvements including the construction engineering. On June 11th, 2019 the City of Monticello and our engineering consultant held the bid opening for this project at City Hall. A&R Services, Open Road Paving, and Duce Construction all bid on this project. Open Road Paving bid \$643,121.64, Duce Construction bid \$476,875.00, and A&R Services was the apparent low bidder at \$393,940.04. Our consulting engineers construction cost estimate was \$273,906.50. This Resolution is required to notify the Illinois Department of Transportation that we desire to award the project to A&R Services and officially requests \$124,000 in addition to the previous requested amount of \$324,000 for a total Motor Fuel Tax Expenditure for construction and construction engineering for this project of \$448,000.

Awarding the project now will allow for the best opportunity to have the project completed by the Monticello celebration on Saturday, September 21st 2019.
