## **BACKGROUND:**

The Monticello City Council included \$660,000 of Motor Fuel Tax expenditures in the FY2021 budget for Sage Drive pavement rehabilitation work and associated improvements including the construction engineering. On April 20, 2021 the City of Monticello and our engineering consultant held the bid opening for this project at City Hall. Open Road Paving and Cross Construction returned bids for this project. Cross Construction bid \$671,839.00 and Open Road Paving was the apparent low bidder at \$650,987.20. Our consulting engineers construction cost estimate was \$537,380.90. This Resolution is required to notify the Illinois Department of Transportation that we desire to award the project to Open road Paving and officially requests \$114,000 in addition to the previous requested amount of \$660,000 for a total Motor Fuel Tax Expenditure for construction and construction engineering for this project of \$774,000. Awarding the project now will allow for the best opportunity to have the project completed before the 2021-2022 school year begins.
