**BACKGROUND:**

The City desires to improve Livingston Street by performing hot mix asphalt (HMA) resurfacing from Market Street to Buchanan Street. Engineering Services will be contracted to ESCA Consultants, Inc. (ESCA). The use of Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) requires submittal of Bureau of Local Roads & Streets (BLRS) Manual form BLR09110 (rev 05/08/2020) attached hereto.

The project is for the hot-mix asphalt (HMA) resurfacing of Livingston Street from Market Street to Buchanan Street. The work will also include cold milling, pavement patching and ADA sidewalk ramp upgrades. Deteriorated existing combination concrete curb & gutter will be removed and replaced as needed. New sidewalk will be placed in the southeast corner of Market Street and Livingston Street to alleviate a gap in the existing sidewalk; the sidewalk will be replaced on the north side of Livingston Street from Market Street to Charter Street; and a retaining wall with upper and lower sidewalk landings will be built to provide ADA compliant access to the building in the southwest corner of Livingston Street and Hamilton Street.

This resolution officially requests IDOT to appropriate Motor Fuel Tax funds in the specified amount of \$76,616.00 for Engineering work as described above.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

It is recommended that the City Council discuss and approve Resolution 2021-45 as submitted.
