**AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING A
RESIDENTIAL WASTE HAULING FRANCHISE AND LICENSE**

WHEREAS, the City of Monticello (“City”) is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (“Code”); and

WHEREAS, the City may approve the method or methods for the disposition of garbage, refuse and ashes, (65 ILCS 5/11-19-5); and

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a competitive procurement process to obtain residential waste hauling services for the City’s residential customers; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals dated August 8, 2022, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference, including any addenda that were issued; and

WHEREAS, the City received various proposals and, after evaluating them under the published criteria and the available information, the City has chosen the proposal of Allied Waste Transportation, Inc. dba Republic Services of Urbana (“Republic”), which is attached hereto as Exhibit 2, as the lowest responsive proposal from a responsible contractor that is in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to accept the proposal of Republic and enter into the residential waste hauling franchise contract as set forth in Exhibit 3, as specified in this Ordinance, and subject to final approval by the Mayor and City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Monticello, Piatt County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. RECITALS. The foregoing recitals are incorporated as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. FRANCHISE CONTRACT AWARDED. A residential waste hauling franchise contract and license is hereby awarded to Republic on the terms set forth in Exhibits 1-3, subject to all applicable laws and regulations and such other and additional terms that may be approved by the Mayor and City Attorney.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. This Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered severable and the invalidity of any section clause, paragraph, sentence or provision of this Ordinance will not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

Section 4. SUPERSEDER. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict herewith shall be, and the same hereby are, repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication in pamphlet form, in accordance with law; and the approval of Ordinance No. 2022-50, “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE V, CHAPTER 50 OF THE CITY OF MONTICELLO CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING RESIDENTIAL WASTE.”
