# a) Ordinance 2015-12 - Financing Agreement with First Mid-Illinois Bank for a new Pierce Rescue Pumper Fire Truck

This ordinance authorizes the mayor to enter into a 10-year finance agreement with First Mid-Illinois Bank. The proceeds will be used to purchase a new Pierce rescue pumper and related equipment for the Fire Department.

## b) Resolution 2015-13 - A Resolution Approving a Term Sheet for the Purchase of Real Estate – Pfizer Tract 8

This resolution authorizes the City Supt. to negotiate a term sheet (agreement) to acquire "Tract 8" from Pfizer. This property is intended to be become a roadway, eliminating a safety concern on Railroad Street.

c) Ordinance 2015-14 – An Ordinance Amending Title VII of the City of Monticello Code of Ordinances to Adopt Regulations Governing Non-Highway Vehicles and Low Speed Vehicles

This ordinance allows licensed drivers to operate registered low speed vehicles and non-highway vehicles on streets under city jurisdiction and not exceeding a 35 mph speed limit.
