

The Council to discuss personnel.

Superintendent of City Services Floyd Allsop explained to the Council about employee Tom Mullvain getting hurt almost a year ago. He got hurt working on a water job at State Street and Center. He hurt his rotator cup and required surgery. Tom has not been able to come back to work because the doctor has not released him. Recently, he came in and talked to Marty Rennels about coming back to work. He handed her what restrictions the doctor had made for him. Since he has been off he has received workman's comp. Marty Rennels in turned called workman's comp to see if we have to find him a job. They informed her as long as we have a job that fits his criteria and not make one up Workman's comp had Mr. Mullvain go to an independent doctor to get his opinion and found out it was the same as Mr. Mullvain's doctor. The job he would need also has to be for forty hours and not take work away from another employee just to give him enough time and then the other employee would not get his time. Attorney Tracy was out of town so Superintendent Allsop called Attorney Lorna Geiler and asked her opinion. Attorney Geiler informed Allsop workman's comp is a form of litigation so the council should not talk to him. A suggestion was to send him a letter asking him what he could do for forty hours. Mayor Mitze stated lets disability settle this.

Alderman Brown questioned how much longer was Renée Weitekamp going to be here. Is she just part time or full time? Superintendent Allsop said she was full time. She is staying on working on the Zoning and Building Ordinances. The Zoning Ordinances have been done and was given to Attorney Tracy eight weeks ago and have not gotten them back. His staff did make a mistake and only copied the front side of the document and not the back so we had to recopy so he would have the front and back. Superintendent Allsop hopes to have it the council for the middle of November meeting. Renée will be leaving December 16th whether her job is done or not.
