
Pending or Imminent Litigation 5 ILCS 120/2 (c) (11)

Supt. Allsop reported to the Council that he had met with the attorneys and Abe Jones had been inside the residences at 902 & 905 Vine Street.

The City of Monticello was granted a search warrant after a Judge had refused to reconsider the owners motion. Mr. Shreffler represents himself at all of these hearings. The Judge has threatened him with sanctions. The appeal process is now being done in State Appellate Court in Springfield, IL.

Mr. Jones showed the Council many pictures of the two residences in question. The pictures were very informative and lead the Council to want to proceed in this case. Mr. Shreffler has done nothing to comply to any of the requests from the City of Monticello Building Inspector. The Council started this process because a petition was brought to them from Mr. Shreffler's neighbors. They will proceed until compliance is met. The Council felt they have a City Building Inspector for a reason and they want to let him do his job. They also feel after seeing some of the photos of the Vine Street addresses that there are life safety issues as well as danger to neighboring homes if a fire would break out.
