2.1.4 Resolution 2013-63 IMLRMA (Risk Management) Annual Renewal

This resolution renews the city liability and worker's compensation coverage for calendar year 2014. The \$181,681.28 premium reflects a 4% increase and takes advantage of the min/max program and a 1.5% early pay discount.

A motion was made by Tim Hayes and seconded by John Miller to approve the Consent Agenda items. A voice vote was taken and all voted yes. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Schreffler was having some issues with his video equipment and was asked to fix it..he did not respond so was asked to leave by Mayor Corrie. He was escorted out of the building and Mr. Brown manned the video equipment.

### MAYORS REPORT:

Mayor Corrie informed the city the Veteran's Day parade was very nice except for the poor weather.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

6.1 Motion – Estimate of Property Tax Levy and SSA #2 Levy – This motion approves the \$550,000 property tax levy estimate for Fiscal Year 2014. The property tax levy will be submitted for approval on December 09, 2013. The Special Service Area #2 tax levy will reflect a rate of .50%. A motion was made by Larry Stoner and seconded by Lyle Murdock to put this property tax levy amount on the December 09, 2013 agenda. A voice vote was taken and motion carried with all voting yes.

#### ALDERMAN'S REPORT:

Alderman Hayes reported that the Halloween event at the Livingston Center had over 200 participants. Alderman Miller wanted to congratulate the Monticello High School sporting events on such a great fall season. Alderman Stoner reported that the Fire Dept is doing well and is run very professionally. Alderman Brown reported that the WWTP staff has had to do lots of repairs.

#### POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT:

The Council and the citizens in attendance were introduced to the newest member of the Monticello Police Staff. Chad Smith will be working the 11-7 shift.

#### SUPT REPORT:

Supt. Allsop reported that there is some exciting things the cities can look forward to, the Gazebo at Burke's Park is being repaired, the city had nine new building permits in 2013, and the recreation master plan will soon be ready for official approval.
