

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF January 25, 2010

The minutes of the regularly scheduled Monticello City Council Meeting of January 25, 2010 held in Council Chambers of the Municipal Building in Monticello, Piatt County, Illinois.

Mayor Corrie led the Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Corrie swore in Kelsey Schluter as the new Student Advisor

Alderman Eades made a motion, seconded by Alderman Hayes to accept the Claims Report for January 31, 2010. Motion Carried

In the Mayor's Report, Mayor Corrie asked the Council if they wanted to do anything about the semi tractor trailers parking on Pepsin Hill. He asked for a couple of Council members to get together and bring more information to a study session. Also, he stated that the First Christian Church is setting up a relief effort for Haiti. The Pastor of the church gave an overview of what their plans were. They are having drop locations around town for people to drop off different items that they are in need of. They have a semi trailer that they are going to load on Saturday February 13.

A motion was made by Alderman Hiller, seconded by Alderman Murdock to approve Resolution 2010-02. This resolution states that the City is interested in issuing tax exempt bonds for the financing of the new hospital. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Hiller, seconded by Alderman Cummings to approve Resolution 2010-03. This resolution vacates the right of way of the street that goes from Route 47 to the hospital. This is needed due to the HUD loan that says Kirby needs to

own all of the property. Once a part of the loan is paid down the street will be allocated back to the city. Motion Carried.

In the Alderman's report, Alderman Hayes stated that summer baseball registration is February 8 through the 18. Registration forms can be picked up at the city building. Adult open gym volleyball is Sunday's from 2pm to 4pm, and Wednesday's from 6pm to 8pm. He also said the design of the new recreation area is coming along well and so is the new pool.

Alderman Hiller stated this Friday is First Friday and Chocolate Fantasy. You can buy tickets from many downtown businesses and from Monticello Main Street.

Alderman Brown said the waste water treatment plant completed sampling for the EPA, and with the melting snow the plant has been busy.

Alderman Cummings gave a list of all the projects that the city crews have been working on.

Student Advisor Schluter stated that the Okaw basketball conference is February 12, 13, 14.

A motion was made by Alderman Cummings, seconded by Alderman Eades to adjourn at 8:22pm
