A motion was made by Alderman Eades, seconded by Alderman Mitze, to accept the Council Minutes from April 26, 201, the Council Special meeting of May 15, 2010 and the Claims Report for May 24, 2010. Motion Carried.

In the Mayor's Report, Mayor Corrie wanted to recognize Student Advisor Schluter for the many scholarships she was awarded.

A motion was made by Alderman Hiller, seconded by Alderman Hayes to approve Ordinance 2010-21. This is an ordinance that rezones the Regal Crown Building. Part of the building is currently occupied by the Faith Christian School, and another business is going to occupy the other half.

A motion was made by Alderman Kuetemeyer, seconded by Alderman Hayes to approve Resolution 2010-22. This resolution opposes the reduction of local government distributive funds. Motion Carried.

Council had a discussion about the Walden Pond Subdivision Annexation Agreement. There is wording in the agreement about Trailblazer Road that would need to be amended if there was to be development along that road.


Student Advisor Schluter stated that there were 112 students that graduated. June 3, 2010 is the last day of school, and there are five teaches retiring.
